Lyric Poetry

- Image based, expressing feelings and observations of the speakers; stanzas may be crafted to reveal different approaches to the feeling, mood or emotion being portrayed.

Narrative Poetry

- which uses images but places them in a clear story, or narrative format. Moves through a sequence of events

Soundscape -

Each word is chosen to blend with other nearby words, a landscape created out of words

Word Packages -
cliche phrases

Lines - all the words on one line of text

Line Break - the word the line ends on, not necessarily the end of the sentence

End Stop - Lines that end in punctuation

Enjambment - A line that only has part of a sentence on it

Effects of short lines

Effective and hardhitting

Effects of long lines

Epic journey or quest, packed with action
and images

Turns (verse) - Changing the direction of the poem

Stanzas - lines grouped together, scenes in a narrative, paragraphs in a composition, gathers together images and relates them closely
