2)drama does not take a lot of time or invested thought. The audience is being told a story vs blindly feeling it out. The experience is completely different than a secluded and repeated reading session.








less thinking to do and are allowed to be less focused, so while drama is sensational and vivid, it is always pre-thought out before the audience even starts
